



Canning Club Membership & WAPOL Club Support Licence Process

General note: This is a high-level administrative guide only. Always confirm current requirements directly with the club and WA Police (WAPOL), because forms, approvals, and legal requirements may change.

Membership Path

Follow these typical steps to join the club.

1. Enquire with the Canning Club.
2. Review eligibility and club requirements.
3. Submit the membership application.
4. Provide identification and any supporting documents required by the club.
5. Attend an induction or safety briefing
6. Wait for committee review and approval.
7. Pay the required membership fees.
8. Receive confirmation that membership is active.

WAPOL Club Support Licence Path

Once the club process is confirmed, these are the general administrative steps involved in seeking approval through the relevant club and WAPOL process.

9. Confirm the club supports the relevant firearm category or approved use.
10. Check the current WAPOL and WA legal requirements.
11. Submit the required club and police paperwork.
12. Club verifies the genuine need and club purpose.
13. WAPOL conducts assessment and background checks.
14. Provide any additional information requested.
15. If approved, the firearm is recorded or approved under the club licence process.
16. Maintain ongoing compliance, secure storage, attendance requirements, and renewals.

Final Reminder

Always check the latest club policies and WAPOL guidance before submitting any application or paperwork.
